



Production Team Leader – Technical

The Production Technical team are responsible for the maintenance of Mechanical, Electrical, Instrumentation, Control, and Automation (MEICA) assets and systems across the Portsmouth Water area of supply. The Team Leader shall lead and direct all Technicians, Craftsmen, Apprentices, and Administrators within the department who are responsible for but not limited to the following:

- Maintaining MEICA assets in line with organisational and manufacturers' procedures and protocols
- Timely repair of MEICA assets, ensuring that breakdowns are met with efficient fault finding techniques and root cause analysis
- Installation and commissioning of plant and equipment
- Ensuring production capacity is greater than network demand
- Procurement of materials and services
- Maintenance of asset management systems
- Planning of work, liaising with internal departments and external contractors
- Dispatch of work orders to the appropriate staff

The Team Leader will be required to provide leadership to the Production Technical team to operate effectively and efficiently. Support for the Production Supervisor at all times in their duties and implement changes required to maintain and enhance the efficient running of the Production department. They will be responsible to ensure all out of hours duties are covered by the Production Technical team and is expected to provide support where required.

The successful applicant will be self-motivated, flexible, and have good attention to detail; ensuring all work is carried out on time, in line with procedures and in full compliance with on-site Health and Safety. You will be willing to develop and learn within the role and have the flexibility and competence to maintain water treatment works, working at all times in line with our values of excellence, integrity and respect.

The role requires the following qualifications (full training provided where necessary);

- Served a recognised apprenticeship in a relevant field
- HNC/HND qualified
- Supervisory qualification (Minimum level 3)
- EUSR Water Hygiene (Blue Card)
- Working in high risk confined spaces (including the use of self-contained breathing apparatus).
- Full UK driving licence. You will be required to undertake our Driver Assessment.
