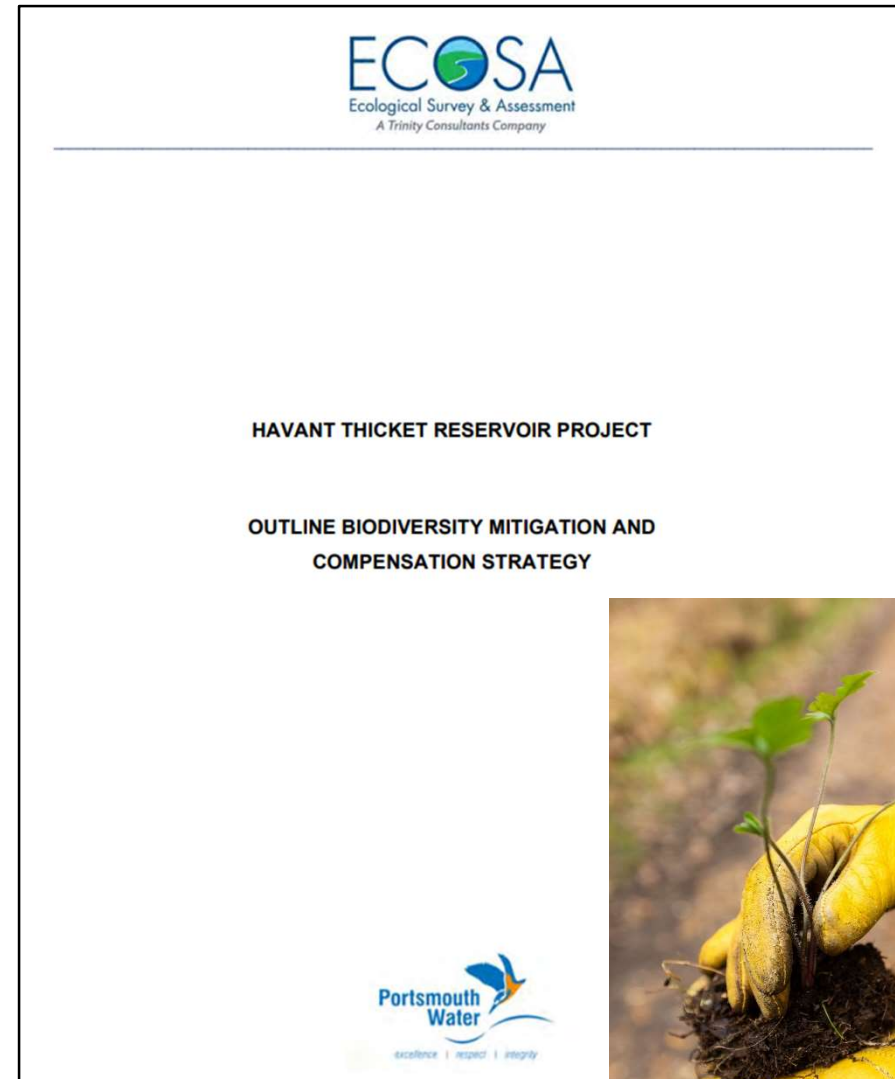

Biodiversity Mitigation and Compensation

- **Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP)**
- **Landscape Ecological Management Plan (LEMP)**
Sets out the long-term management of habitat creation / enhancement
- **Detailed Biodiversity Mitigation and Compensation Strategy**
Currently being drafted by Atkins and will be finalised when the contractor is in place.



Havant Thicket Reservoir

80-hectares woodland site update

- Project total of 200 hectares of woodland creation / restoration
- Shortlist of two locations for 80 hectares of woodland
- Site to be selected in the summer, allowing time to finalise the land agreement.
- Landowner will commence work in the winter planting season.

Southleigh Forest Woodland Management Plan

- Positive feedback about the plan from consultees
- Environmental sub group to review the plan before submission
- The plan will then be updated every 10 years
- The plan will be submitted to Forestry Commission to confirm that it meets UK Forestry Standard criteria.

Havant Thicket woodland

- Forestry England have been restoring and creating new habitats in Havant Thicket
- Opening areas to let in more light
- Creating space for native trees, increasing biodiversity
- Improving habitat for reptiles, bats, dormice and birds.



What we've done so far:

- Habitat creation in Havant Thicket woodland
- Creation of forest meadows, by clearing young birch trees in previously clear-felled areas to create permanent open spaces
- Installation of hibernacula (underground chambers) and log piles, to provide shelter and hibernating sites for reptiles.

Protecting badgers

- Badger surveys took place in 2018 and 2020 on site - only inactive and dis-used setts found
- No evidence of active setts was recorded, but habitat on site remains suitable for foraging and sett construction
- To mitigate this, we need to close a badger sett, under licence from Natural England
- The sett will only be closed, once it is confirmed it's no longer in use.

Sapling rescue

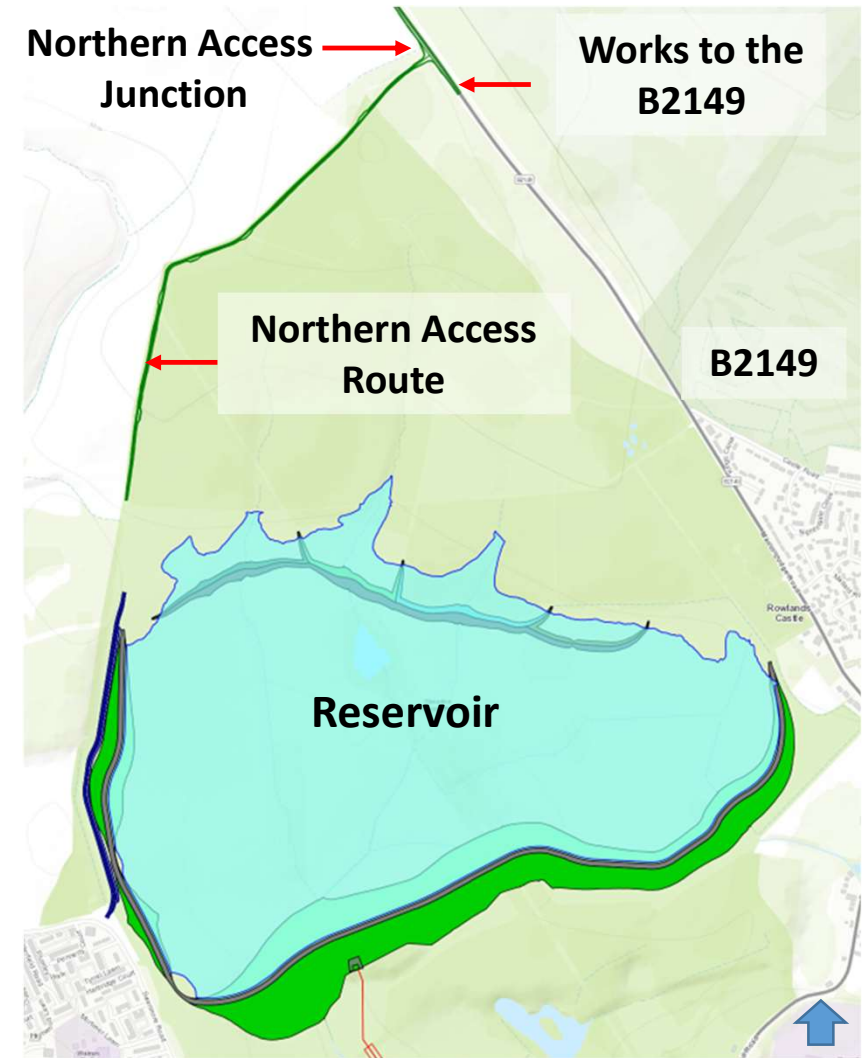
- Volunteers are relocating around 300 saplings from the Avenue
- These will be replanted in compostable pots and temporarily stored at Gipsies Plain
- Around 200 tree saplings have been grown from seeds gathered from the Avenue
- These will be grown in a sapling nursery on site.

Progress since the workshop:

We've been working closely with our landscape architect, ecologist, tree specialist and drainage engineer to:

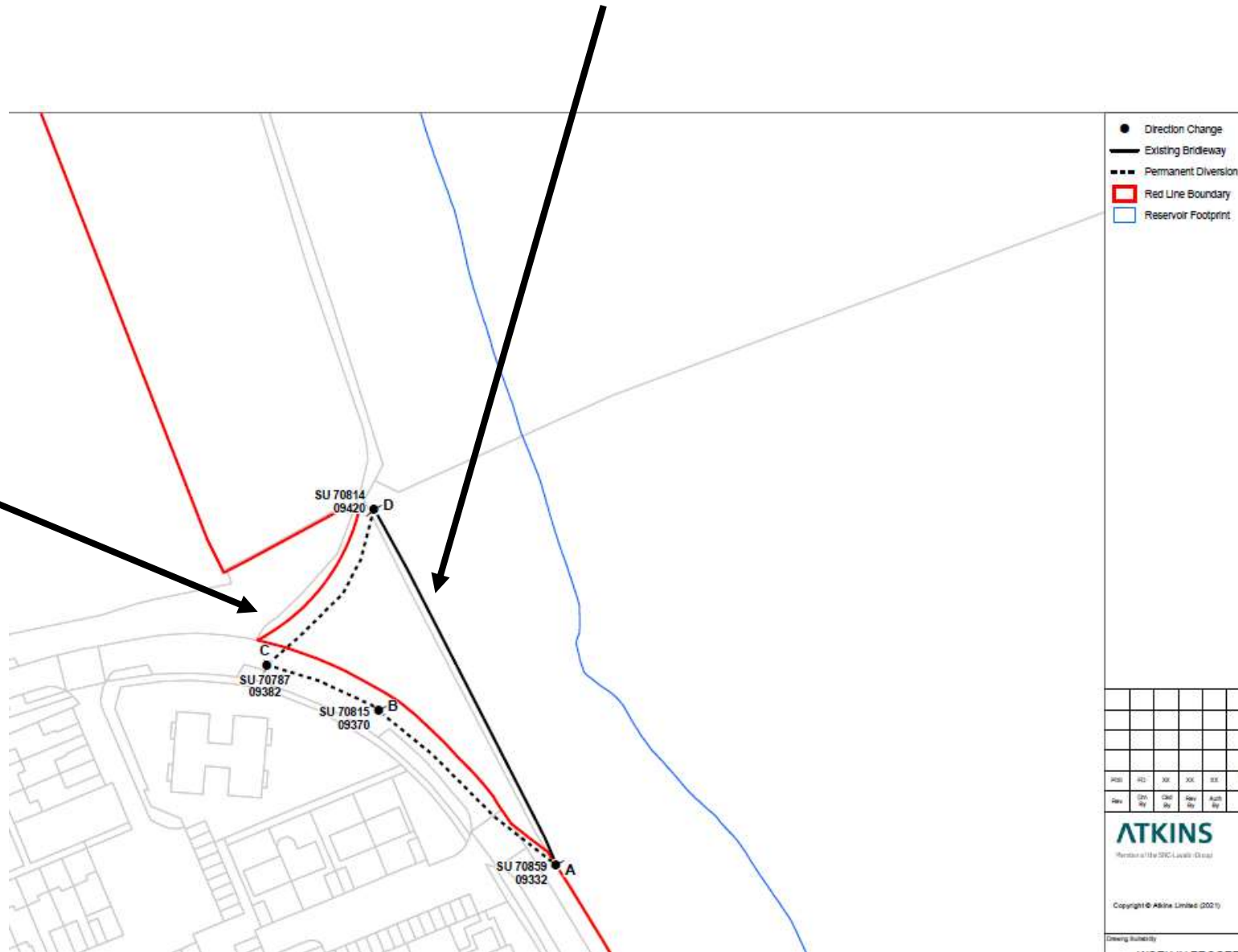
- Further reduce the impact on trees
- Retain the rural character of the woodland setting
- Determine the location and species of new planting
- Design the crossing point for multi-user access to and from Horndean.

bridleway

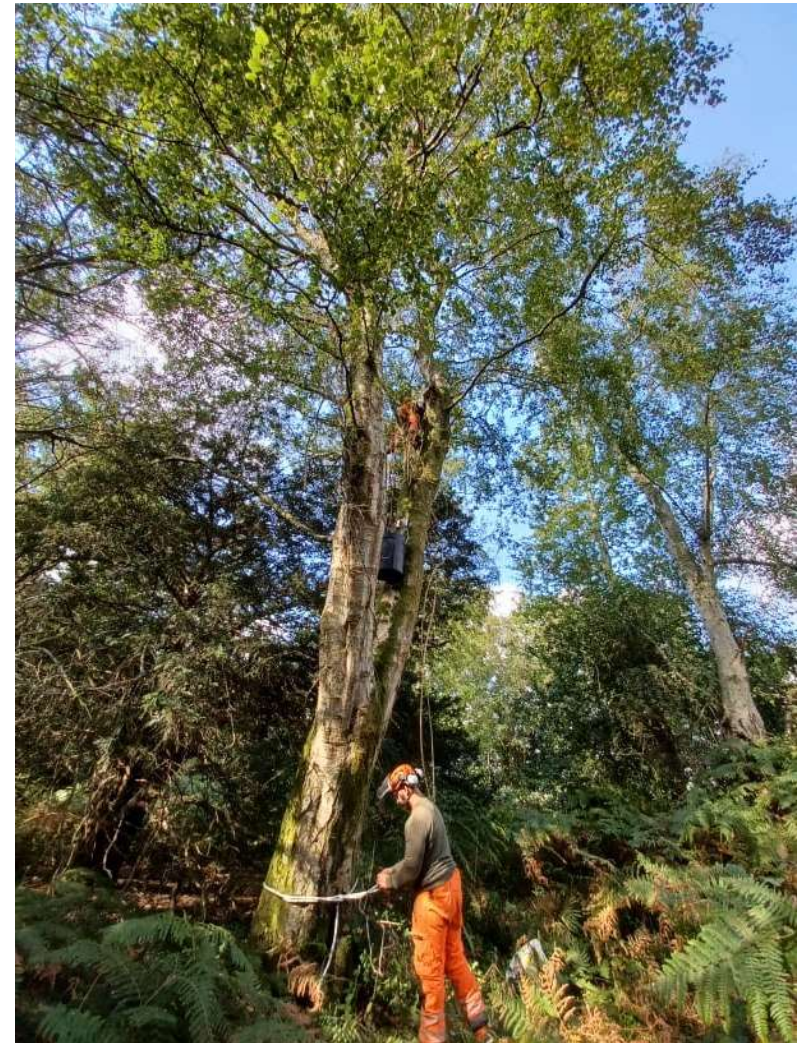
Alternative

Tree removal works

- Tree removal on B2149 for site entrance and along the Northern Access Route track planned for April 2022.
- Work being timed to ensure no bats are disturbed
- Measures also be in place to protect birds and ensure no nests are disturbed
- Next phase of main site clearance work will be taking place in September and October 2022.
