



Leakage Technician

We are looking to recruit a Leakage Technician to fulfil an important position in the business, and offer a role that offers great opportunities to learn and progress.

We are looking for a driven, trustworthy, technically minded person who is keen to learn new skills. Working at all times in line with our values of excellence, integrity and respect, you will be working as part of the team to further reduce leakage on the water network. Key activities of the role include carrying out reactive and proactive leak detection and acoustic logger deployment/collection. The individual will need to use analytical skills and state-of-the-art equipment to find hidden leaks below ground.

The role is customer facing and involves use of technology, so good personal and technical skills are essential, and a positive attitude is a must. Ideally the applicant will have experience in Leakage Detection.

Applicants must have a valid Driving Licence and will be required to undertake our Driving Assessment. Self-motivation is important as the individual will be expected to work primarily outside in most weather conditions using a Company van. In return we offer a 36.25 hour working week, 24 days annual leave (rising to 28 based on continual years' service) and a stakeholder pension scheme. Typically working from 8am to 4pm, Monday to Friday, although occasional night work will be required.
