What will you be doing?

- Conduct interviews and workshops with stakeholders to gather and analyse information on current processes and identify potential impacts
- Create / update business process maps
- Construct detailed change impact assessments (CIA's) to detail impacts on people, processes and technology
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to develop effective readiness plans
- Hold regular readiness planning review sessions with impacted business owners
- Assist in the creation and delivery of change-related communications, such as infographics/ briefs, presentations, and announcements
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of change initiatives, collecting feedback from stakeholders and analysing adoption rates
- Provide guidance and support to project teams and stakeholders throughout the change process. Participate in post-implementation reviews and identify areas for improvement
