Based in our Laboratory, this role will be responsible for the day to day running of allocated analyses and tasks including the collection and analysis of water samples, and ensuring their work meets the required regulatory requirements. You will be collaborating with your colleagues in the Water Quality Department, Customer Services, Network and Production teams, as well as other internal/external customers.

What will you be doing?

Key Responsibilities

- General Laboratory Duties (Solution Prep, Bottle Prep, Result Data Entry etc.).
- Daily check of monitoring systems.
- Interpreting test results, ensuring they meet regulatory requirements and adhere to ISO 17025 standards, and registering results on central systems.
- Prepare, calibrate, operate and maintain equipment and instruments used to evaluate the quality of water samples.
- Ensure the proper storage, handling, transportation and analysis of drinking water samples.
- Taking water quality samples from across our supply area, at customer properties, water treatment works, pumping stations, reservoirs, streams and rivers.
- Maintain housekeeping standards (sampling / lab facilities)
- Participation in Departmental Projects
- On Sampling rota and sample reception duties as required.
- Reporting any work area issues directly to the Work Area Supervisor.
