The role is also responsible for reporting against short, medium and long term financial deliverables set by our regulator and shareholders.

What will you be doing?

Key Responsibilities

- Provide timely and accurate financial analysis and advice to stakeholders.
- Maintain financial modelling tools to ensure accuracy and integrity, ensuring that these are agile and can accommodate scenario-based modelling.
- Treasury Management including maintaining the Treasury Management tool (Titan) and use outputs to provide insight, analysis and recommendations to relevant stakeholders.
- Run scenarios through relevant modelling tools to assess the impact of potential decisions on cash flow and EBITDA as well as the financial ratios and price controls.
- Co-ordinate the annual budget process including the production of relevant targets and deadlines, consolidation and analysis, working closely with the wider finance team to ensure deliverables are achieved on time.
- Co-ordinate the reforecasting process including the production of relevant targets and deadlines, consolidation and analysis, working closely with the wider finance team to ensure deliverables are achieved on time.
- Assess and monitor the company's overall financial health and investment portfolio.
- Collaborating closely with regulatory financial manager for company's 5-year planning cycle and assessment of performance throughout the AMP.
