Portsmouth Water are recruiting a Water Quality Sampler to join our growing team. This role interacts with the Water Quality team as well as the Production team. The role is also customer facing and interacts with the public.

Key Responsibilities

- Taking water quality samples from across our supply area, at customer properties, water treatment works, pumping stations, reservoirs, streams and rivers.
- To perform on-site sampling analysis and inspection duties to meet regulator requirements and in-line with our UKAS accreditation.
- Interpret test results, accountable for water sampling activities, ensuring they meet regulatory requirements and adhere to ISO 17025 standards.
- Perform Company van checks / minor maintenance as required.
- To ensure an adequate stock of all bottle types and required reagents, ensuring the proper storage and transportation of drinking water samples to a suitable location.
- Prepare, operate and maintain equipment and instruments used to evaluate the quality of water samples.
- Checking laboratory systems to ensure compliance during the sampling run.
- Support with customer contacts and complaints where required.
- Ensuring all work is carried out in line with the Company's WQ Quality Management System (QMS), adhering to ISO 17025 and Drinking Water Testing Specification (DWTS).
