- Work collaboratively with the Main Contractors providing visionary leadership to ensure that commissioning processes, procedures, programmes and assurance is an exemplar for all future Reservoir Projects Planned in the UK, through continuous improvement and a commitment to excellence.
- Monitor compliance with requirements in asset design, delivery, and testing; monitor delivery performance; and work with contractors to address issues and improve processes.
- Ensure health and safety are at the forefront of everything completed on our sites.
- Support contractor and Operations liaison during the design process, promoting innovation, best practice, and compliance with quality standards; planning for commissioning as part of the design process, system integration, operability, and maintainability.
- Communicating and reporting with internal and external stakeholders.
