What will you be doing?

Key Responsibilities

- Preparation of drawings schedules, maps, reports and other electronic designs, for a range of purposes to include updates of visuals and schematic designs, to support operational processes and procedures.
- Manipulating and updating of network records and asset databases, using Geographic Information Systems and other corporate systems.
- Maintenance, update, and distribution of external special datasets, to include the development of automated processes supporting data update and water treatment / distribution operations.
- Interpreting documents, images, and other sources of validated information to capture, attribute and compile digital data to defined specifications, ensuring drawings are appropriate, checked and meet the expected levels of technical quality.
- Investigation, and resolution of issues, performs calculations, liaising with technical resources when required.
- Maintaining the integrity of the Geographic Information Systems, managing the data, supply and distribution of all information in support of Portsmouth Waters needs and objectives, supporting the efficient working of the water level management systems in order to mitigate risk.
- Updating datasets, following or in response to changes with business processes and procedures.
- Supporting the Design Team and Production Team with multi-utility design plans.
- Carrying out quality checks, ensuring attributes are completed and correct documentation is provided.
